9.	 Draft: Annual Report Recommendations Review a. New 2019 Annual Report Recommendations 1. Removal of the 3% THC cap, and establish a purchase limit of "4.5g THC over 90 days" a. Purchase limit does not apply to the terminally ill – no mCBD Board approval necessary b. Purchase limit can be increased by the certifying healthcare practitioner – no mCBD Board approval necessary 2. Removal of the felony disqualifier for patients and caregivers 3. Addition of PAs, ARNPs, and Podiatrists to the definition of healthcare practitioners 4. Require pharmacists or pharmacy techs in dispensaries 5. Provide physician access to the patient registry 6. Develop protections for facilities housing medical cannabidiol patients and products 	

7. Require Department research (observational study)
