Administrative Rule Update (ARC 6159C)

- Providing certifying practitioners the authority to request cancellation of a patient's medical cannabidiol registration card
- Striking the real-time requirement for transmission of manufacturing data to the Department to allow for the implementation of a simpler, more cost-effective solution;
- Allowing veterans to be eligible for the reduced application fee option when enrolling in the program when confirming documentation is provided.
- Removing certain low-value waste tracking requirements because of unnecessary difficulties with tracking for licensees and enforcement for the Department;
- Clarifying registration card application language based on program evaluation;
- Formalizing administrative rule waivers that are currently in effect,

- ➤ These rules had their final date with the ARRC on July 19
- Rules became effective on July 20




Rulemaking Update


Priorities:

- Marketing and Advertising
 - Draft rules assembled, based on CT
 - Stakeholder meetings conducted with licensees
 - Fielding comments prior to noticing rules
- Updates and clarification to reflect simplification of MFG data requirements
- Others based on program evaluation



Data Review: Healthcare Practitioners






- > 1,821 unique certifiers represents a 24.6% year-over-year increase
- An average of 30 new certifiers per month since July, 2021




Data Review: Patient Adoption




- 11,676 active patients represents a78% increase year-over-year
- Program staff have processed an average of 975 new patient applications per month over the last year
- ➤ Automations have been implemented to account for volume, and movement to a digital registration card to reduce costs and improve efficiency



Data Review: Dispensary Sales









- Cumulative July dispensary sales (\$940,100) represents a 77% increase in year-over-year monthly sales (\$531,673)
- > 7,054 dispensary visits represents a 100% increase in year-over-year monthly visits



Data Review: Product Purchases





- > Sales of vaporizable products have increased by 20.4% year-over-year (45.2% in July, 2021)
 - Introduction of additional vaporizable product forms
- ➤ Sales of high-THC formulations have increase 11.1% year-over-year (62% in July, 2021)
- Implications of OTC hemp-derived cannabinoid products
